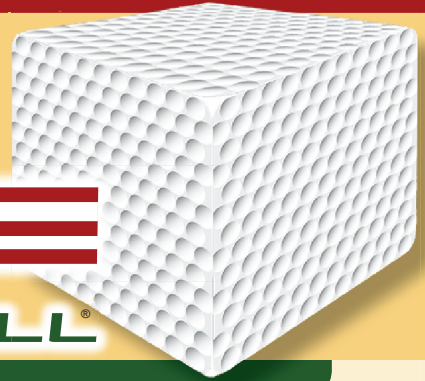

The Square Golf Ball® floats. This may seem strange, considering The Square Golf Ball® weighs more than a traditional golf ball (see March 6, 2015 blog). How can this be? We were a little surprised ourselves. The factor making the difference is the inner core. While The Square Golf Ball® and a traditional golf ball have solid, or virtually solid cores, the proprietary core of The Square Golf Ball® allows the buoyancy factor to overcome the weight. We can't envision a scenario where you'd place The Square Golf Ball® into water, but know that should that situation arise, you won't need to dive to retrieve it!
