Because The Square Golf Ball® does not have a solid inner core like a traditional golf ball, The Square Golf Ball® will shatter if struck, hit or dropped from a high place. The Square Golf Ball® won't just be scratched up or dented – it will be in a thousand pieces with virtually no hope of reassembly. Many finer courses will have regulations against littering or leaving garbage behind. Striking The Square Golf Ball® will present the same situation, and unless you're willing to spend 15 minutes picking up pieces, you'll be far better off by simply following the instructions and use The Square Golf Ball® in an indoor setting, as a novelty conversation piece.
