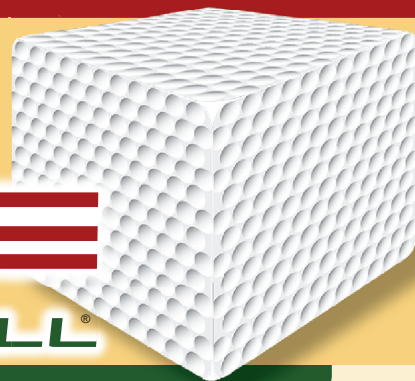

Adding A Tee To The Square Golf Ball, Part I

The Square Golf Ball is able to be equipped with a standard inverted wooden golf tee. This adds a new dimension of character and uniqueness to The Square Golf Ball, and in truth, the process is relatively simple. Please use the navigational link on any of our main web site pages to locate the Tee It Up instructions. We have also included short videos on what to do and how to do it. We have elected to just use a wooden tee, but with the variety of tees on the market, probably any tee could be adapted to work in this fashion, and may present an equally good looking final product. Please bear in mind, we are providing information concerning adding a tee simply for visual effect. This is not intended to show you how to tee up The Square Golf Ball for actual use in golf – which would end quickly in disappointment and pieces galore. The instructions we've provided only require basic tools and a basic ability to use those tools. The inverted tee design is certainly the easiest to accomplish, and this option allows you to reverse your decision and return The Square Golf Ball to a desktop situation, with nobody seeing any evidence that a tee was once involved. The inverted tee diamond is a little more tricky to produce, and after you are finished, it would be almost impossible to reverse the procedure and use The Square Golf Ball on a desktop without an visible telltale sign of alteration.
